NCAG Led "Vets4Vets Creative Workshops".

This past summer, a series of twelve creative art workshops, cosponsored by Lutheran Family Service's At Ease program and NCAG, was conducted for veterans as part of a group called Vets4Vets at Bellevue University's Veteran Support Center in Bellevue, NE. Workshop topics included making clay vessels, photography, animation and music writing, among others.

Vets4Vets is a peer support group of Iraq and Afghanistan-era Veterans interested in the common goal of sharing experiences, "venting" and just hanging out. In these
